Dates and Hunts:

The dates indicated are actual hunting days and you arrive a day prior and leave the day subsequent to your hunt date. ALL our hunts are **back pack hunts** and your main means of transportation within the hunting area will be our **helicopter**, which is included in the hunt price.

Add on species on single species hunts:

Add on species on single species hunts are available and can be taken during your pursuit for your main species as you go along. However, some hunters wish to be moved to different hunt locations (prime goat or caribou habitat) to increase their odds on taking add on species after their main quarry is taken. As a result a **helicopter flight fee of 2,500** will be charged to move to and from a prime location for that specific species you are looking for (doesn't apply on mixed bag hunts and moose hunts). After you take your add on species the trophy fee (see list) is payable to the outfitter.

Included on all hunts:

- YOUR** hunting licence
- ALL** tags for desired species available at the time
- ALL** helicopter flights necessary to obtain a representable trophy
- ALL** bush plane flights within the hunting concession
- ALL** trophy fees payable to the Government of Canada (Royalties)
- ALL** payments to the NRHPF (Non Resident Hunting Preservation Fund)
- ALL** federal sales tax occurring on any payments (5% GST), with non resident tax rebate applied
- ALL** export permits and Cites documents
- YOUR** personal guide (1:1)
- ALL** camping gear excluding sleeping bag and mattress
- ALL** field preparation of your trophies, salting and drying of capes, boiling and bleaching of skulls
- FULL** service in main camp – all inclusive (accommodation, food, beverages, alcoholic drinks)
- UNLIMITED** satellite phone usage in camp
- FULL** expediting service in Ft. Simpson on arrival and departure
- HANDLING** of export permits in Ft. Simpson before you leave
- FLYING** of trophies to Ft. Simpson at the end of season (October)

Not included:

- TROPHY** fees payable to Outfitter after kill - see price list
- TRAVEL** and hotel expenses
- TROPHY** and meat flying to Ft. Simpson during season unless space is available
- TROPHY** shipment from Fort Simpson to your final destination - see info on trophy shipment
- TAXIDERMY** expenses
- GRATUITIES** to your guide and camp staff

Deposit Requirements:

To reserve your space we require a deposit of 50% of the hunt price up to a year before the hunt takes place. The balance of the hunt price together with the charter fee is due by May 15th the year of the hunt.

A 25% deposit is required to hold your space for bookings made more than a year in advance. An additional 25% will be due by Nov 15th the year prior to your hunt with the balance and charter fee again being payable by May 15th the year of the hunt. A hunting contract and a receipt will be issued for your initial deposit, which will also indicate the remaining payment schedule.

Payment options:

All funds are charged in Canadian Dollars and payments can be wired to our CAD account in Whitehorse, Canada. We certainly accept personal cheques for hunt deposits. For payments in camp we can take traveller cheques, certified cheques, bank drafts, cash and VISA or MASTER card (2.9% service charge applies). We are sorry for the inconvenience but for payments in camp we cannot accept personal cheques.

For payments in any other currency than CAD, the daily rate of "Bank of Canada" will be used for conversion the day your payment takes place.

Cancellation policy:

For cancellations prior to March 1st an administration fee of \$ 2,000 is withheld. For cancellations after March 1st the year of your hunt no funds can be reimbursed, however a replacement hunter of your choice may be substituted. We highly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance.
