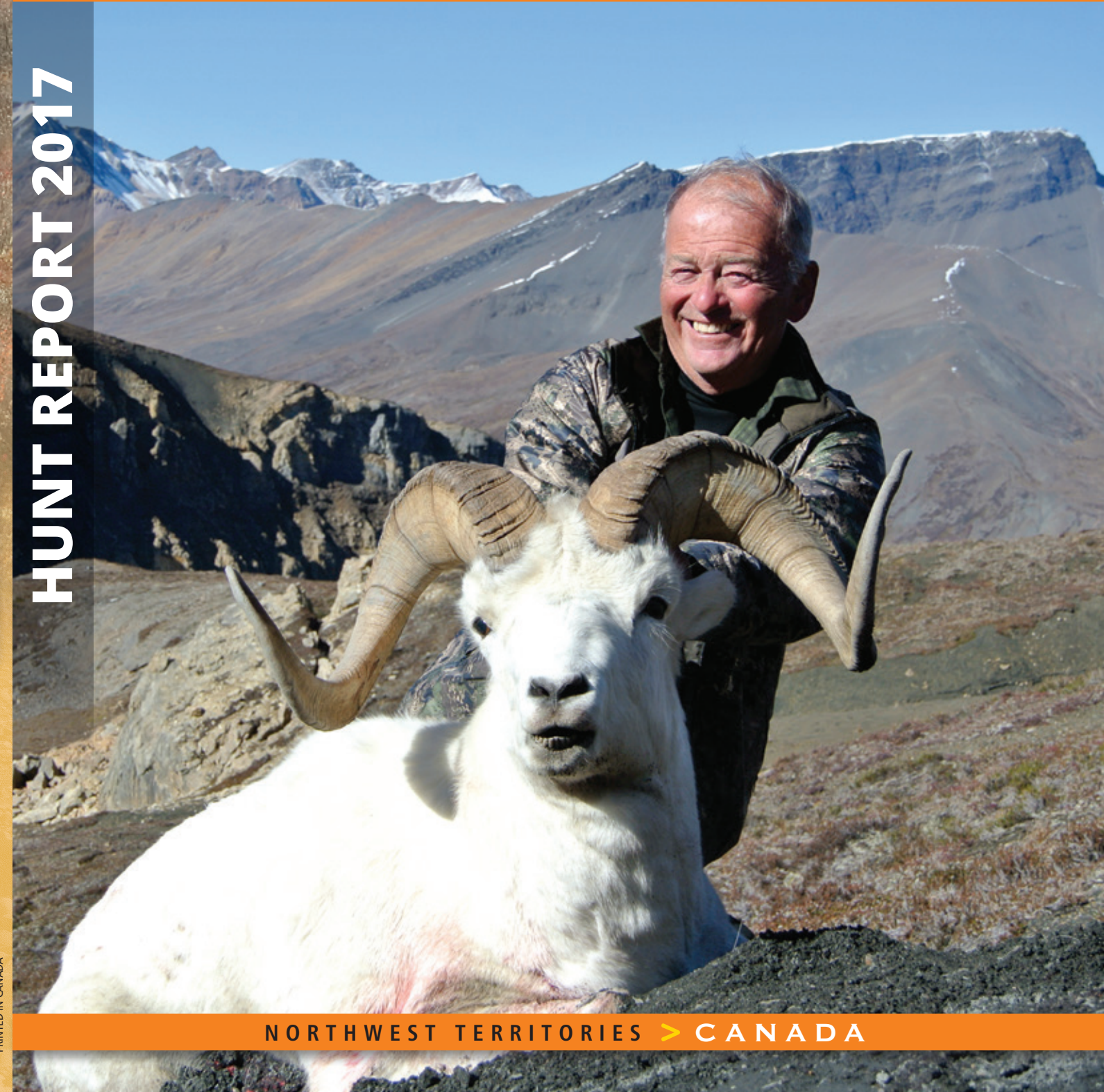

Every season is defined by one big characteristic – 2017 was the ‘best weather ever’. Basecamp saw a total of five bad weather days. The rest was pure sunshine. This does not necessarily translate into the ‘best hunting year ever’.

Sheep hunting is, of course, so much more fun in sunshine than fog and snow – easy to spot, yet always a physical challenge.

Unfortunately, one of 27 sheep hunters had only a single chance at a trophy ram, and was unable to take it; and out of 15 attempted moose, one was shot and lost, and two clients went home empty handed (one was gambling on a huge bull).

This year’s highlights were a **book ram** taken in later September, another which scores slightly less but is a most beautiful **twister**;

as well as the **biggest and oldest billy** ever taken in South Nahanni – one loses count of the age rings after 16. We did manage to find several **record book bulls** amongst the scattered caribou, and rounded out the picture with **four wolves** and a **black bear**. And the most exciting news for the **future SNO hunter?** There is a moose in ‘Hellhole’ aka ‘The Burn’ that made the plane’s wing drop and Sunny almost fall out the window during a **moose scouting** trip. Two hunters went after him, but I guess it’s up to **you** now to go and get him!
